
Who knows exactly what we will do, we have not planned it yet!

Grounds Update

Nicholsons have now more or less completed their work on refurbishing the borders on Rutherway. The row of multi-stemmed Amelanchier should be in bloom very soon, and the borders to the north of this row have a mixture of shrubs and herbaceous perennials. The two large hornbeam trees in front of the Crescent east have been replaced with native silver birch trees: the hornbeams were too big for the space and were taking too much light from the nearby houses. As the same time the border between the Crescent east and The Villas has been replanted. During the spring there will be further planting in Merrivale Square. On Plater Drive, a number of old plants have been replaced with new shrubs and perennials. At the Aristotle Lane entrance the mixed hedges planted a few years ago by volunteers are now thriving and protecting the fences from graffiti.

This Autumn a community bulb planting will be organised to replenish the spring bulbs planted by enthusiastic volunteers some years ago.

OxGul-E eCharging cable guide trial on Waterside!

You may have seen news of the cable gulley trial as part of Oxford's efforts to increase EV uptake and facilitate charging for properties that don't have a driveway or other off-street parking. It aims to eliminate cable trip hazards and bulky/ unsightly/ improperly used plastic cable covers.

The updated highways code now includes specific wording about not creating tripping hazards with EV charging leads.

If you weren't aware, due to the unique layout of the estate, many of the properties on Plater Drive have "public highways" running in front of their homes in the form of the council-adopted footpaths. Currently, 28 Plater Drive is part of the trial. Look on our website for more information on eCharging.

News from the Waterside Management Company

Please remember to apply to WMC for permission regarding any planning submissions and alterations as stated in the covenants for each Waterside property.

The electricity substation in Rutherway gets items regularly abandoned outside, and bins are not removed promptly. This is a safety hazard and signage is about to be ordered indicating that nothing is to be left there as 24 hours access is required, SSEC is being informed and CCTV is also being costed. If your neighbours are away please try to bring their bins in.

Jubilee funding of £500.00 has been agreed, this will enable purchase of folding tables.

New signage for Merrivale Square is to be installed at adult height, to be more prominent.
